Call for synopses to Produce Short Films

Call for Short Film Ideas

The United Nations World Food Programme (WFP) in partnership with Roya Film House (RFH) invite amateur filmmakers and fresh graduates of Fine Art faculties in particular women to share their ideas in the form of synopsis of a three-minute short film. Applicants should submit a one page synopsis that presents an overview of the genre, themes, structure, plot, setting and characters for their original short film.

The films will focus on co-relations between food insecurity, poverty and Gender Based Violence (GBV) and should highlight causes and effects of food insecurity and its link to GBV including negative coping mechanism such as early and child marriage.

Five best synopses will be provided with an opportunity to work with RFH to produce their films that will be screened on a short-film festival in March 2020 and the best film will be awarded.

Final Deadline: 22 January 2020

TERMS & RULES

1. The deadline for submitting the synopsis is January 22, 2020.
2. All **synopses** need to address the topics: food insecurity, poverty and Gender Based Violence (GBV) + causes and effects of food insecurity and its link to GBV including negative coping mechanism such as early and child marriage.
3. Synopses will be considered only if they are of a total running time of 3-5 minutes
4. Applicants should be fresh graduates of Fine Art faculties and freelance amateur filmmakers.
